

What is the EDO ART EXPO and the *Edo-Shodo* Exhibition?

Each fall, the NPO Corporation Tokyo-Chuo Net holds the EDO ART EXPO and The Edo-Shodo Exhibition by local school children, major events hosted across four of Tokyo's wards (Chuo City, Chiyoda City, Minato City and Sumida City). These exhibitions aim to introduce the arts and culture of the Edo era and utilize approximately 50 different venues, including well-established local shops, hotels, shrines and centers of culture or tourism. The theme of the 16th EDO ART EXPO is "Journey with Ukiyo-e". The 12th Edo-Shodo Exhibition by local school children has about 5,500 entries, from which 285 awards will be presented

with the support of 46 sponsors. Award-winning works will be displayed at selected EDO ART EXPO venues. During the exhibition period, you can enjoy a fun and fulfilling 19 days with a wide variety of events, such as waterside events, various rallies (ART Rally, S&N Rally, and Ukiyo-e Rally), and store fairs where you can present coupons to redeem special offers.

We hope everyone gets a chance to take advantage of all that the EDO ART EXPO and The Edo-Shodo Exhibition by local school children have to offer, and takes away a new understanding of the unique culture of the Edo era.

Please participate in the "Smartphone Ukiyo-e Stamp Rally" Wiyo-e Rally Free Participation using a smartphone, or the "Ukiyo-e Stamp Rally" in which

four-color stamps are pressed onto a paper mount. The "Smartphone Ukiyo-e Stamp Rally" is a digital stamp rally that uses a smartphone browser. The rally will be completed by visiting four venues and acquiring four types of *Ukiyo-e* (digital stamps). You can apply for the *Ukiyo-e* Rally Prize lottery using the application form or application ticket (postcard format). In the "Ukiyo-e Stamp Rally", participants go around four venues and collect stamps in four colors (purple, yellow, red, and black) on the application form. You can enter the lottery for the Ukiyo-e Rally Prize by putting the application form in the application box or by mail.

About Edo

Edo was the former name of Japan's capital city Tokyo during the Edo period (1603-1867).

As the center of politics and economics, Edo had become a sprawling



metropolis, reaching a population of more than 1,000,000 people - surpassing that of Paris and London at the beginning of the 18th century. Edo was renamed Tokyo in 1868 (the 4th year of the Keiō period) under the Meiji Restoration.


